

Red Stone Drive Wildfire Fuel Reduction Project.

About a dozen volunteers over a two-day period hacked, sawed, and cut the dense sagebrush located behind the corner of Red Stone Drive and Boulder Heights Drive. The objectives were to reduce a dense stand of sagebrush at the corner of the two roads as well as to cut back the sage that bordered Windsong Road and the park below. The age and density of the sagebrush has created a wild fire fuels hazard that has to be periodically thinned. The end result of this removal project significantly reduced the amount of fuel at the corner and minimized a wildfire avenue into our neighborhood.
